ILP Conferences, the Just Jumpin' Jump Rope Team, & Learning to Give Service

Hello West Point Families,

Your children are excited to have you come to our ILP (Individual Learning Plan) Conferences next week! They are creating goals and each student will give an overview of what they have learned so far. They will be held next Wednesday and Thursday, Nov. 7-8. We also have our Reflections Awards at 7 PM this Thursday night, on Nov. 1st. Come and see the creativity and talents that our West Point Wildcats are building!

Last week we had two special events. First, the "Just Jumpin" jump-rope team came last Thursday from Cache Valley and showed us some amazing rope-jumping! It was an almost-continuous presentation from a team ranging from 5th graders to college students. They'll be back in a week, on November 9th, to sell beaded jump ropes at lunch recess next Friday. Short ropes (7' 8' 9' & 10') will be \$9 and long ropes (14') are \$12.

Second, last Friday the students had a visit from Service Boy and Service Girl, who are two ordinary superheroes, also known as Marvin & Jessie. During our life-skills assembly they needed help from the students to remember how important it is to give service! A crafty character, Apathy Woman, had a plan to make Service Boy and Service Girl (a.k.a. Marvin & Jessie, played by Mr. Hummel & Mrs. Thompson) forget about being empathic, which means to be caring for others. But by watching the students be so kind and mindful of others, Marvin & Jessie each remembered who they themselves were! They realized how important and fun it is to not only be aware of the opportunities to serve everyone around us. Giving service is a really important way to show that we are mindful of others. Even Apathy Woman (played by Mrs. Hess, our speech teacher) changed her heart, and gave a helping hand. It felt great!

It's great to be surrounded by families and children who love to serve others. The many volunteers that are in our school each day is just one example, and this next week we also get to celebrate the service that our Veterans have given to our country! Let's always be on the lookout for ways we can serve at home and in our communities. We can change the world by serving and being mindful- one person at a time.


